### **THE PROCESS**

Applicants must:

- 1. Be currently employed in the industry for a minimum of 2 years.
- 2. Have a minimum of 8 years relevant experience in the industry.
- 3. Have completed a Pump Selection training course e.g. NZMPTA, Davey or Grundfos online (or equivalent).

4. Present details of work history.

- 5. Provide a minimum of two work related referees.
- 6. Satisfactorily complete a skills/knowledge assessment.

Applicants are required to have a broad knowledge of the industry and a prescribed standard of skills and knowledge that will be assessed by an independent assessor before certification is awarded.


